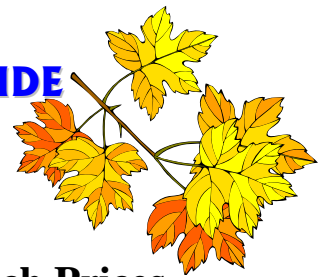

## Directions to Eagle Ranch Trails

From the junction of 54 HWY and 13 HWY in Collins, MO: Go 5 miles West on HWY 54 to HWY J. Go 1 mile south on J HWY. The Ranch is on the East side of the road. Local restaurants, including "Smith's", within 6 miles.

### **Trail Ride Rules:**

1. Negative coggins test on all mounts.
2. No rough riding in camp or on trails.
3. No alcohol allowed while on the trail – upon return to camp, feel free to enjoy the drink of your choice.
4. No stallions without advanced permission.
5. We reserve the right to refuse any reservation.
6. All camps must be quiet by midnight.
7. Dogs are Allowed, but must be on a leash and not allowed on trails.
8. No ATV's , motorcycles, or bicycles allowed.

### **Camping:**


-  Primitive campsites: **\$10.00 per night**
-  Electrical hook-up campsites: **\$19.00 per night**
-  Lakeside campsites: **\$10.00 per night**
-  Camping includes **free** bottled water, ice and fire wood


### **Horses:**

-  Stalls: **\$8.00 per night per horse \*** (Includes **free** cleaning when horse leaves the stall)
-  Trail usage fees: **\$10.00 per horse per visit**  
\* All horses must have current negative Coggins test papers at check-in.

## **CABINS**

-  **\$52 per night.** Cabins have been reserved for saddle club members.

-  **Cancellations:** Please call and cancel as soon as possible, so others on the waiting list can come.

-  **Reservations:** please let us know what time you will be arriving. If you are arriving late, call and let us know if possible.
